6:40 pm	Public Comment Community Commission of Police Oversight (CCPL) - Representative attending to give us a rundown of the functions of the department (appointed by Elliott Payne) - Planning PBS documentary on MPD - Annual meeting with Chief of Police

	• Mentions protection from premature demolition and support of change of ownership with commitment to attempt restoration • Mandi is meeting with 20+ neighborhood members now (at the time of meeting) and 50+ people were at the location yesterday (4/19)– substantial community support Motion __Cassandra__ / Second __Kate__ - motion passes Update regarding traffic on Tyler St NE between Broadway and 14th Ave related to Bauhaus Brew Labs's car shows, including updates from CM Payne's office about next steps to address the problem • Cassandra sharing as a resident adjacent to Bauhaus • Experiencing noise and safety issues during car shows • Area is part of Logan Park traffic reconstruction • MPD has been unresponsive (3/29 event), personal outreach to Bauhaus unproductive • She reached out to Elliott Payne's office– was told speed bumps are not used in cases like this; but residents calling for traffic calming could be helpful • Waiting on response from Community Planning and Economy Development department • Noise angle: perhaps requesting shortening the event (since they are operating legally) or asking for a head's up • Suggestion to see how the city navigated issues with Mayslack's– several city representatives were present– drinking in parking lot after closing time (business is still responsible for the culture they have created) • Communicate directly with Bauhaus owners • Shared testimonial about safety concerns, trash left behind • Shared experience about a disruptive business– what it took for change was everyone documenting litter, making calls • Resident experience seconding recklessness and safety concerns
7:00 pm	Discussion regarding crime and safety concerns at Tyler Street Stacks • Cassandra presented on “teen takeovers” – getting together and causing chaos • 4/11 group gathered in parking lot (not residents), lots of yelling, MPD showed up at 3am; TSS resident was attacked and threatened with a gun (one of multiple neighbors that right) • TSS said they would work with victim on rent, apologized for incident (not the first time– being tracked since summer 2025) • Testimonial about disruption, hostility, and safety for a woman
